One drawback of a truck crane is that it is not stable enough sitting on tires alone in order to be able to lift the major loads that a hydraulic crane could handle. Thus, so as to fix this issue, outriggers can be extended from the deck. The outriggers utilize hydraulic pressure to be able to lift the truck slightly off of the ground, making it stable and balanced. The crawler crane is unique in that it has huge tracks on the bottom of the crane. These huge tracks are really similar to bulldozers and backhoes. The tracks enable the crane to successfully move around a construction locations.
